


## Beaufort County 250 Committee Historic Site Tours

### Fort Frederick Heritage Preserve – Port Royal



The southernmost fort in British North America from 1726 to 1758, it was initially constructed of logs, and was later improved with tabby walls, which were completed in 1733.

A small fort, its garrison was a company of British regulars until they were transferred to Georgia in 1736, after which local militia units occupied it.

The fort was built to protect against Spanish raids from St Augustine but it was never attacked.

With the completion of the 375 x 400 foot, tabby Fort Lyttleton on Spanish Point in 1762 it became obsolete.
